## FLOOD

### WHO IS IT?

An overflow of a watercourse occurs when a flood, or a substantial rise in water level, causes the watercourse to breach its banks. This scenario is the most prevalent.

Urban runoff: during periods of intense rainfall in urban areas, water fails to infiltrate the ground due to its impermeable

### WHO IS IT?

Fires impact forests as well as various other types of vegetation. Often, fires ignite outside forested areas: along roads or railways, in wastelands, fields, gardens, and similar locations.

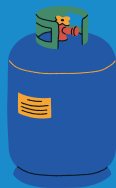

## Transportation of hazardous materials

### WHO IS IT?

These materials possess physical or chemical properties that pose a risk to individuals, property, or the environment.

These encompass explosive, flammable, radioactive, toxic, corrosive, or polluting substances.



## Earthquake

### WHO IS IT?

Earthquakes, a potentially lethal natural hazard, are ground tremors caused by the abrupt release of energy along a fault line.

### WHAT ACTIONS SHOULD BE TAKEN?



Shut the windows and cover the vents with damp cloths.

Refrain from consuming tap water.



### WHAT ACTIONS SHOULD BE TAKEN?



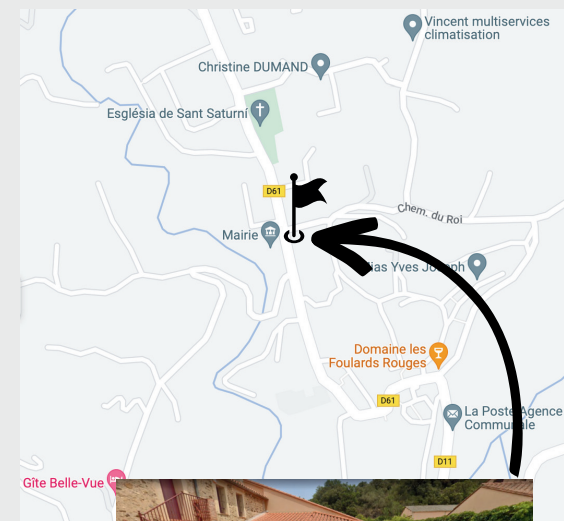
Seek shelter behind a retaining wall or beneath robust furniture.
